Confirmation of June 2010 Minutes:

Confirmation of minutes moved by Roger Nethercote and seconded by Brett Sowerby. Carried.

Matters Arising from June 2010 Minutes:

• The high jump bags can be repaired for \$66 a mat (total \$264). We should also check if they can be connected in any way.

It was moved by that we go ahead with the repair. Carried

 Bunnings in Valley Heights is closed for the rest of the year. We received a date from Bunnings North Penrith for a BBQ in August but there was agreement that we are too busy with registration to be able to take up the offer.

It was moved that we do not have a BBQ this winter & relook at this for next season. Carried

- We only have one school, Elison PS, for the school visit program. Jim will attempt to get at least one more school
- A \$3000 grant was received for a PA system. This includes \$1853 for equipment & \$1147 for
 installation by the council. The amplifier should be placed above the fridge in the canteen.

It was moved that we place a purchase order for the equipment to commence installation. Carried

- The AFL Storage shed will be placed next to the container. This will entail removal of the fixed timing stand. We need to repair our portable timing stand to replace this when required.
- A working bee will be held on Sunday 15th August to repair the long jump pit drainage using an excavator, assess the long jump runway issues, mark the sector lines for Throws day and possibly clean the amenities & back room if there are enough volunteers on the day. The estimate for excavation and supplies is \$200. An email will be sent to the club members.

It was moved that a maximum of \$300 be spent on the working bee. Carried

- The Council have confirmed they will repair the shot put circle by the beginning of the season.
- The Council will assist us in applying for a grant to fix the canteen, toilets and septic tank. This grant is due 6th August
- Council do not know as yet whether they will have funding for a First Aid course as they did last year. Instead we should ask for qualified first aid officers at registration.
- We have 7 registrations so far for Throws Day & many more to come. Entries close the 13th
 August. The following members have agreed to volunteer on the day:

 - o Canteen/Data Entry/Certificates Sharon Jones, Sarah Peterson, Colleen Carmody
 - We will also attempt to get a coffee van for the day
- The undermining of the shed has been fixed by the council
- The bottom cage will be repaired on July 23rd
