

Recorder's Report for 2017

Congratulations to all swimmers who have competed, trained and participated in the activities of our Club over 2017. As I've reported during the year through my Sunday Summaries this will only be a brief review of results for the year. I need to again thank my temporary "bag" people who have brought along the watches for Sunday swimming, particularly Ian B and Sue.

Aggregate Competition for the Jodi-Ann Menzies Trophy

The number of swimmers competing for this trophy is, unfortunately continuing to decline with only 12 club members scoring points in 143 events. This compares with 14 members in 178 events last year; 2015 – 16 swimmers and 181 events; 2014 - 17 swimmers and 170 events. Six swimmers scored over 100 points with some places decided by the number of 10 point swims as point scores were even at the end of the year. I even had to go down to the number of 8 point swims for two places as the results were that tight! Results will be announced following the AGM.

Endurance 1000 Competition for the Alan & Lynette Davis Cup

We had our two stalwarts of this competition again complete the entire program this year. Congratulations to Ian B and Sue. Although we didn't better the total number of points recorded by the Club last year we were only slightly down on 2016 numbers. Catherine completed all but the butterfly swims and Peter managed to complete all five 400m IM swims. I hold out some hope of at least one 800m IM in 2018. Tom also completed all but the butterfly events and the 800m IM's. We had just these five swimmers achieve Blue or White awards this year for 505 points or more for the year. There are plenty of areas to improve in to get somewhere near our 2014 and 2015 numbers.

Christmas Handicap

We tried again, successfully this time, to run our second Christmas Handicap on the morning of December 3. We had eight entries, with Adrian, unfortunately, having to withdraw on the morning. Most swimmers elected to do free (how boring!) with Peter and Ian B choosing IM's and Tom doing Backstroke. Peter and Ian P both put in PB performances in the heats with Peter also collecting a new Club Record. After the run of heats we had to farewell Catherine and moved onto the semi's. In the semi's five of the six swimmers were all within 2.5 seconds of each other. We farewelled Tom, Jenny and Ian B. Peter put in another PB and Club Record performance. The final consisted of Peter, Darryl and Ian P. Peter led off with Ian P following 35 seconds behind and Darryl a further 4 seconds. It was quickly developing into a race between Peter and Ian P with Peter touching first, Ian P a mere 0.28 seconds behind (oh for another metre!) and Darryl continuing to swim to his handicap a further 4 seconds in arrears. Another PB and Club Record to Peter with Ian P adding another PB to his morning. It was a great morning of sprint swimming, the only time of the year that the club members attend with the aim of swimming as fast as they possibly can. Put December 9 in your diary which is when our 2018 event is scheduled. It's a lot of fun not only to compete in but to watch.

State Meets

State Long Course – February

We increased our representation for this meet when 12 members competed – Ian B, Adrian, Jacqui, Tom, Darryl, Amanda, Peter, Philip, Kelly, Kirsty, Susan and Catherine. We achieved 12 1st places, 14 2nd places and seven 3rd places. The Men's 4x50m 200+ Free of Darryl, Tom, Peter and Adrian also came home with gold while the Women's 4x50m 200+ Free team of Susan, Jacqui, Kelly and Kirsty came fourth in their event.

State Short Course – July

Ten swimmers competed – Shane, Ian B, Adrian, Tom, Darryl, Amanda, Peter, Philip, Dorothy and Catherine. A great haul of 14 golds, 13 silver and 17 bronze medals. A very successful meet for the Club.

State Short Course Relay Meet – August

Five Men's teams represented the Club. They brought home 1 gold (4x50m 240+ Free team of Martin, Peter, Tom and Darryl), 3 silver and 1 bronze. Well done, men. Ladies, time to step up in 2018!

State Long Distance Long Course – October

Tom and Darryl competed in the meet held at the Ringwood pool. Tom collected two second places, 1 LCPB and 1 Club Record while Darryl brought home two gold medals from his two swims.

National Championships, Gold Coast – March

We had only one representative of the Club at this year's Nationals but congratulations go to Adrian in bringing home two gold medals, two Branch records and one bronze from four events. A marvellous achievement.

Australian Masters Games – Launceston - October

Adrian, Darryl and Ian B collected a lot of metal from the Launceston pool with Adrian winning all his four events (with two more Branch records), Darryl also winning four from four while Ian B collected two first places and two second's.

Records and PB's

An amazing 157 new Club Records this year (more than double 2016's figures) due in no small part to Peter's change in age group. He scored a remarkable 103 new records for the year. Catherine also needs to be recognised for setting 30 new records while still staying in her age group. Fantastic effort. Congratulations again to Adrian his four Branch Records for the year.

77 PB's were recorded this year by 17 swimmers led again by the Ya with 12 PB's from 13 events. She was the only swimmer to achieve a White award for more than 50% PB's. Check your individual timesheets distributed earlier this month for your own achievements in relation to PB's. Please note that split time PB's achieved in events that you didn't swim during the year are not included in these figures.

Open Water Competition

This competition continues to gather strength in 2017 with 21 members swimming in 177 events and an extraordinary 386.6 km in total. Sue and Dee continue to dominate in both the number of events that they compete in and the distances that they achieve.
