From Our Head Coach

The winter competition period has begun in the best possible way. Ryde-Carlile has won the first two meets of the winter season with victories at the Speedo-Carlile Cup and the inaugural North West District meet.

For those new to the competitive side of swimming the winter schedule provides a progressive competition programme. As the season progresses each meet offers a higher competitive level as the qualifying times for these meets gets tougher. As a swimmer progresses their competitive season gets longer. Below is the competition schedule or progression;

- Club Meet
- District Meet
- Metropolitan Championships (June)
- NSW Age Championships (August)
- NSW Open Championships (August)
- Australian Short Course (September)

Soon the championship meets will begin with Metropolitan and this is a great time to focus competition preparation into training. Considering its an Olympic year I have included some insights into Pieter van den Hoogenband's Olympic preparation. Pieter is attempting to win 3 consecutive 100m Freestyle Gold medals. In his way is our own Eamon Sullivan, the current world record holder.

" During competition, you always need to focus on your own race to swim the best race possible. That should be the goal of every swimmer; to improve yourself instead of wanting to win." From van den Hoogenband's perspective, he doesn't feel any stress before a major race: "I'm just focusing on my race and pumping myself up. Swimming is a sport in which you can't do more than perform at 100 percent, so why should you worry? You shouldn't complicate things too much."

Before the "big race," Hoogie likes to get plenty of sleep as well as finding enough time to prepare himself mentally. "I'm not stressed by the fact that others are better starters and turners the swimming will take care of itself. Everything adds up to the final time, and the only thing that matters is the final time."

But the way Verhaeren (Coach) sees it, achieving your best "final time" still comes down to one simple, but critical element: "Even at this level, technique is still the most important."

"Until the day of the competition, we keep working on the little details, such as reducing drag by improving body position and by working on technique. We also try to learn something from every workout. Everything you do needs to have a purpose. I want to see the effect of every set." – Swimming Technique Magazine
