Visitor Policy

Background

Queensland Masters Athletics recognises that to assist in increasing its membership it is important to encourage potential members, to provide an environment that retains existing members and to support younger competitors who may eventually become members.

There may be occasions when members are accompanied by persons under 30 who wish to compete. QMA will accommodate such requests whenever possible, subject to the conditions of QMA's policy set out below.

Policy

Visitors over the age of 30 are encouraged to attend training and competition events at all QMA venues. Fees for competition events are to be determined by the individual regions but should include QA Base Membership fee on the first visit of the season to ensure insurance coverage.

Note that if the visitor belongs to a Queensland Athletics or Athletics North Qld affiliated Club, or to Little Athletics, they have insurance cover and will not need to pay the QA Base Membership fee.

Under age visitors intending to compete must be accompanied and supervised by an adult and are required to pay the same fees as over 30 year visitors. This policy reflects the fact that insurance cover is required by all competing individuals.
