



Player Code of Conduct

A player's public behaviour will be closely observed by others as he represents his League at special events. Any behaviour that is unlawful or disrespectful to others is a slur on everyone associated with the team.

Any behaviour contrary to this Code or the MBL Player Protection Policy and any behaviour detrimental to the game of baseball must be notified to the League. If the player's behaviour is found to be in breach of this code of conduct, the player may be banned from the remainder of the tournament/event and may affect future representative opportunities.

Player Behaviour

To have a successful Little League All Stars campaign, MBL has expectations of player behaviour and all players are required to follow the following conduct guidelines:

1. The uniform will be worn in a respectable manner;
2. Be punctual to training and games;
3. Be prepared for training and games – make sure you have all your equipment;
4. Misbehaviour will not be tolerated;
5. Always respect your coaches, team members and opponents;
6. Abuse of equipment will not be tolerated;
7. During games players ARE NOT to leave the dugout;
8. No eating including gum and seeds in the dugout;
9. Accept the role that the coaches have assigned you with gratitude. You may be required to play in positions (including the bench) that suit the team not the individual;
10. Compete by the competition conditions and rules;
11. Verbal abuse against umpires, opposing players or spectators will not be tolerated;
12. Control your temper – no criticism by words or gestures;
13. Refrain from profanity;
14. Report all injuries.
