



Elite Player Support Policy

Macarthur Baseball League ("the League") encourages members to realise their potential and athletic abilities. It may be possible at times to offer financial support to successful competitors. This policy outlines the guidelines for such financial support.

Who is eligible under this policy?

Members who are financial members of the League when they participate in the elite team are eligible to apply for support.

An elite team is a State or National team participating in an event sanctioned by Baseball NSW or Baseball Australia.

How does an eligible person apply for this financial support?

The eligible person (or his/her parent or guardian) will need to apply in writing to the League.

The request is to include details of the elite team and its competition schedule.

The request is to be submitted prior to the elite competition commencement.

How will the applications be assessed?

Applications received in the correct manner will be considered by the Executive Committee of the League.

Each application will be considered on its merit.

	<p>Applications will be prioritised according to the level of competition, e.g. applications for a NATIONAL team will be considered before applications for a STATE team.</p> <p>Applications for support for privately-organised touring teams will not be considered.</p>
<p>How much money is available?</p>	<p>The League, as a not-for-profit organisation, can offer no guarantee of support.</p> <p>The Executive Committee will assess its financial capability at the time it considers eligible application/s.</p> <p>The League may reconsider any application, whether previously supported or declined, if funds become available for the purpose.</p> <p>Any amount paid will not set a precedent for the assessment of subsequent applications.</p>
