By Laws

- I. The first team mentioned in the fixtures is the home team and has the responsibility of supplying the plate umpire.
- 2. The second team mentioned is the away team and has the responsibility of supplying the field umpire.
- 3. Players are to play in the area in which they live or attend school. If for any other reason, such as insufficient numbers or over enrolment, a transfer must be organized and sanctioned by the committee.
- 4. Home team and spectators sit between home base and first base. Away team and spectators sit between home base and third base.
- 5. Home team fields first. Away team bats first.
- 6. Plate umpire can cancel the game at which they are umpiring on the grounds of safety.
- 7. The chief umpire is the only person who can cancel an entire days play on the grounds of safety.
- 8. Games must commence within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time. At 10 minutes after the scheduled start time, the game will be started to standard game procedures.
- 9. The score cards from games shall be completed with all players first and surnames, correct scores and umpires signature. Place the completed cards in the box at the canteen straight after the end of the game. Incomplete cards will void team score. Penalty 9-0.
- 10. The umpire shall not permit any player out of uniform, without proper cause, to participate.
- II. Aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated. Ejection from all games and playing area until tribunal hearing will result from:
 - A player striking another player, or
 - Abusing an umpire, or
 - Striking an umpire.



General Information

FEES

Tee Ball \$100, Little League Machine Pitch \$145 including \$10 refundable shirt deposit. Teeball & MP \$195. All fees must be paid before the third playing date (unless prior arrangement has been made with Treasurer). Un-financial players are ineligible to play on the third playing date. **Kidsport** grants are accepted for fees & uniform.

GAME ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATES

Certificates for milestone games: ie 25, 50, 75, 100 & 150 will be given to the team coach for them to present on the day that the player's milestone game is played.

UNIFORM

Players must wear their full uniform to each game, including sponsor's shirt, Hornets hat, pants, socks, sneakers or football boots (no metal studs).

SCORE CARDS/ UNDER-6 ATTENDANCE CARDS

It is the <u>home team's</u> responsibility to complete the score card in full, incl the umpire's signature and under-6 teams complete their own attendance cards. All cards are place in the score box, on the canteen counter, immediately after the game. This information is used to allocate game achievement certificates to players.

APPROPRIATE DRESS STANDARDS

Parents who take the diamond in an official position, ie plate umpire, field umpire or base coach, must be appropriately dressed and wear closed-in shoes and a hat.

ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION

SAFETY & COMFORT

Mouth guards are advisable and sunscreen is available at the canteen. Flies are very friendly, and ticks are a problem during the first half of the season due to the moist grass. Please check your children and yourself thoroughly when you get home.

DIAMOND LOCATIONS (See page 14 for a map)

Diamond I & 3 are used for Little League baseball games which commence at 9.30am. When going to and from your team's diamond, please ensure that you and your children walk <u>around the boundary line</u>, not across the oval, so other games are not interrupted and to avoid being hit by a ball.

CANTEEN ROSTER DUTIES

Please take note of your team's canteen roster duty dates.

The canteen is run for the convenience of all players and their families and is a important fundraising source for the Club to keep fees low, but to keep it running, parent support is vital. Canteen requirements:

- Please be prompt to your canteen roster duty.
- Two adult volunteers are required & must be over 16.

Children are not permitted behind the counter area due to safety reasons, ie hot urn and food —they must sit to the side of canteen on the chairs.

- Covered shoes and appropriate clothing must be worn.
- No smoking in the canteen.

If no-one arrives to perform their teams roster duty, unfortunately, the canteen will be closed.

Eastern Hills Hornets—Code of Conduct—PLAYERS

Players who registered with Eastern Hills Teeball and Baseball Association, are required to abide by the Player's Code of Conduct.

- I. Learn the rules of teeball and always play by them.
- 2. Never argue with an umpire, opposition umpire or official. If you have a problem, discuss it with your coach and allow them to take the necessary action.
- 3. Your coach or umpires will not tolerate verbal abuse of, or deliberate physical interference with opponents.
- 4. Strive to play the game to the best of your ability at all times, both at practice and during games.
- 5. Respect the time and effort put in by your coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
- Teeball is a team game. Encourage your teammates even when they make mistakes. Remember every player makes errors and has off days. Never ridicule opponents or teammates.
- 7. Accept that at times you may be required to take your time on the bench. When on the bench encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
- 8. Respect your opponents and appreciate their good play. With-out opposition you would not be able to play the game of teeball.
- 9. Play to enjoy the game and improve your teeball skills.
- 10. Respect the equipment provided for your use. Teeball equipment is very expensive and should be used responsibly. Abuse of equipment such as throwing of helmets or bats will not be tolerated.
- 11. Always think safety to avoid injury to yourself and others.
- 12. Foul language of any sort, will NOT be tolerated.

Eastern Hills Hornets—Code of Conduct—COACH

Coaches who coach a team registered with Eastern Hills Teeball and Baseball Association, are required to abide by the Coaches' Code of Conduct.

- I. Be reasonable in your demands on young players' time and energy.
- 2. Always think safety first.
- 3. Know the rules of teeball and be sure your players always play by those rules.
- Develop team respect for opponents and officials. Do not abuse or ridicule players or officials and do not allow your players to do so.
- Ensure any discussions with umpires are kept below the level of argument. Remember your players' look to you for example. How you accept a decision will be reflected on your players.
- 6. Ensure whenever possible all players have equal time on the diamond. Avoid overplaying the talented players, the average players need and deserve equal time.
- Discipline should be fair and consistent. Ensure all players know what is expected of them at practice and during games.
- 8. Do not tolerate any players abusing equipment or misbehaving to the detriment of other players at any time.
- 9. Keep yourself informed of sound coaching principles and seek more skilled advice when necessary.
- Remember your players are playing teeball for their enjoyment. Endeavour to make the learning process both pleasurable and informative.
- Remember that players need a coach they can respect.
 Be generous with your praise when deserved and set a good example.
- 12. Foul language of any sort will NOT be tolerated.

Eastern Hills Hornets Code of Conduct—PARENTS

As a parent of a child registered with Eastern Hills Teeball and Baseball Association, you are required to abide by the Parent's Code of Conduct.

- I. Children play teeball for FUN. Accept any mistakes as part of their learning process. Remember the game is for their enjoyment, not yours.
- 2. Don't leave your child at teeball, stay and support them, volunteer to help and discuss your child's progress with the coach.
- 3. Applaud good play from both teams and encourage your child that honest effort is as important as victory.
- 4. Encourage your child to always play within the rules of teeball and accept the umpire's decision.
- Never ridicule, abuse or yell at a child for making a mistake.
- Offensive behaviour from parents or spectators is not acceptable under the Rules of Teeball and stern action will be taken against offenders.
- Recognise the value and importance of the volunteer coaches and officials. They give of their time and knowledge to provide organized teeball for your child and they deserve your respect and support.
- 8. Teeball is a team game. Accept and understand that times your child may be asked to take a turn on the bench.
- 9. Not all children can be champions. Do not force an unwilling child to participate in teeball or expect more from your child than their best effort.
- 10. If you disagree with an official or coach, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the person in public.
- 11. Foul language of any sort will NOT be tolerated.
- 12. Be aware that if these rules are not abided by, the offending parent/s will be asked to leave the ground.
