



## Managers / Coaches Position Policy

All coaching staff personnel (Head Coach & Assistant Coaches) must lead by example both on and off the field, especially in regards to respect, ethics, dedication and tenacity.

- Managers/Coaches must have Appropriate Accreditation Levels. Manager Level 3, Assistant Coach Level 2;
- Possess a Working with Children Check if they have no child playing in the team. If they have a child in the team, then they must apply for a WWCC immediately after qualifying for the Nationals;
- Attend all Selection Tryouts;
- Arrange and attend Pre-Tournament training sessions;
- Communicate effectively with the team's parents and/or guardians regarding expectations of players and parents.
- Ensure wellbeing of the team at all times;
- Ensure that you are on time for all meetings and games;
- be a positive role model in behaviour and personal appearance and ensure my comments are positive and supportive;
- keep up to date with the latest 'Rules of the Game', trends and principles of their application;
- Refrain from any form of personal abuse towards players or other officials;
- Commit to travel with the team if they qualify for the Australian Nationals / World Series.
- Dedicate significant effort to facilitate the achievement of the team goals at training and whilst onsite at the competition;
- Abstain from alcohol and tobacco whilst executing duties associated with this position; and
- Adhere to Baseball WA and Baseball Australia's policies.

### **When traveling to the Australian National Championships: (except from Baseball Australia)**

A Manager/Coach's public behaviour will be closely observed by others during his/her participation at the Australian National Championships. Any behaviour that is unlawful or disrespectful to others is a slur on everyone associated with the event. Any serious breach of this code, or any behaviour detrimental to the game of baseball, will be notified to the Championship Director.

If, in the opinion of Baseball Australia, there is a serious breach of the Code of Conduct the Manager/Coach will be banned from the remainder of the Championship, the State Association notified and the Team Official sent home on the first available means of transport. Any additional expense incurred will be the responsibility of banned official.
