

HOW TO OBTAIN AN ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER NUMBER FROM NSW GOVERNMENT

You may have heard of the **Active Kids** Program from NSW Government that enables the parent/guardian of a school age child to claim a voucher for \$100 that is valid until 31st December each year. As of 2020 two NSW Government vouchers are available- each valid for 6 month periods (January-June, July-December). The voucher can be used to offset approved sports costs, including our club's T ball and baseball, by \$100. Make sure you use the voucher in the validity period.

Eastern Suburbs Junior Baseball Club is a registered PROVIDER. That means you can offset your registration fees when you register your child. Just make sure to obtain your voucher number from NSW Government **before you register on our web site** - you will need it then.

To obtain your voucher number for your child:

-click on box FIND A PROVIDER

-in "enter sports/activity type" - select BASEBALL from the drop down menu

-in the "search by provider name" box type - EASTERN SUBURBS

-click "search" and the system will identify **EASTERN SUBURBS JUNIOR BASEBALL** as a Provider club.

-click on "apply for voucher" box you will need to then establish a **NSW Government Services** Account if you do not have one already].

When you register your child on our club's website your will be asked to enter the voucher number for the player. If valid the \$100 discount will be applied to the total fee before you pay.
