



PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Dated: 21 July 2017

Any breach of the Mets Code of Conduct will be reported to a Mets Executive Committee and may result in suspension. The Macarthur Baseball League is committed to providing a sport and work environment free of sexual harassment, where individuals are treated with respect and dignity. The league will not tolerate sexual harassment behavior under any circumstance and will take disciplinary action against anyone who breaches the policy.

1	I/We will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, umpires, parents and the public at large at all games, training sessions and events.
2	I/We will place the emotional and physical well being of our children ahead of any personal desire to win.
3	I/We will demand an illegal drug and alcohol free sports environment for our children and all other children in the association.
4	I/We will encourage our children to always treat other players, coaches, parents, fans and umpires with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
5	I/We will encourage and promote team spirit and will endeavour to have my child wherever reasonably possible to attend all games, training sessions and events related to the baseball season. I will endeavour to notify the coach or manager at least one hour prior to the training session, game or event if our children are unable to attend.
6	I/We will mediate any differences with coaches, fans and officials away and distant from the children and in a professional and dignified manner. We understand that the coach is in control and has the position of authority of the children during games, training sessions and events.
7	I/We will refrain from excessive "sideline coaching" and shouting.
8	I/We will recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches as they give up their time and resources to provide recreational activities for our children.
9	I/We will advise the coach or manager if unable to co-supervise our children during training sessions, games or events and make available an emergency contact number.
10	I/We understand there is a duty of care to be undertaken to the club uniform.
