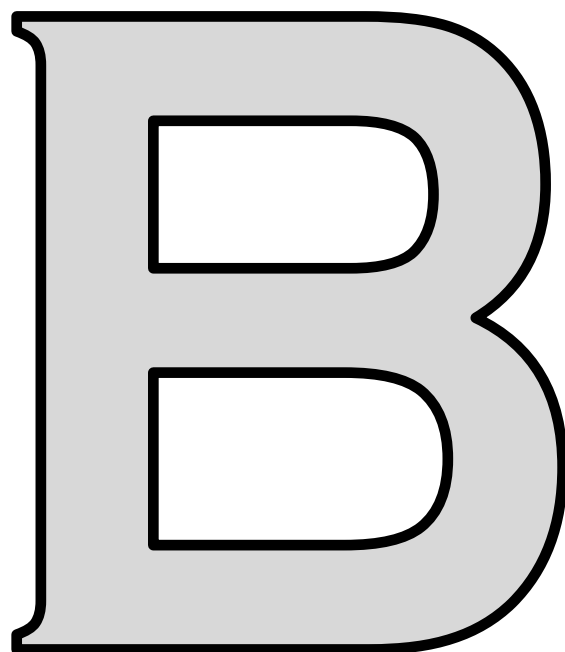

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Another season gone and another great year for the Belmont Baseball Club.

In 2012 we fielded seven junior and seven senior teams. All senior sides qualified for the finals series, with three collecting minor premierships along the way. From here we had six teams make it through to grand finals. Unfortunately we only managed two major premierships.

We clinched the first grade title in one of the best games of baseball I have ever seen. Our side lead for the majority of the game before the Toronto Tigers managed to tie the game in the bottom of the ninth inning. Our boys only needed one more dig to get another run on the board and then shut out the Tigers in the bottom of the tenth and take the Newcastle Baseball Association first grade title for the 5th consecutive year and the 34th in our clubs history.

We also collected the Club Championship for the 13th consecutive year and the 42nd time in our clubs history.

Our juniors were well represented in all age groups fielding teams in every division from under 8s through to under 16s, with our under 16 Sporties beating the undefeated Toronto Tigers 17-4 in the grand final. It was great to see again our club have such large numbers of kids participating in the sport and there is some great young talent coming through the club.

We also had 14 players from different age groups make representative teams and I'd like to congratulate everyone on their successes.

I'd also like to thank all of the parents, coaches and scorers who looked after these junior teams and made sure the kids got a game each week.

Away from the diamond, the club's plans to build a new canteen continued and I am happy to say that we now have full council approval to complete this development. Funding is now our biggest issue with the project to be an estimated cost of well over \$100,000. We recently submitted an application for State Government funding that we hope will be a major contributor to the project

This year saw a change of venue for our annual presentation night. It was a fantastic night and great to see everyone get spruced up for the occasion. The Belmont 16ft Sailing Club provided a much larger function room and better accommodated our growing club.

Our club's success doesn't happen by accident and I would like to thank and congratulate the committee for all the tireless and thankless work that they have undertaken. I cannot thank you all enough. You all continue to amaze me with your efforts and it makes me appreciate what a special club we have.

I would also like to thank and congratulate the players, coaches, scorers, BBQ and canteen staff, ground crew and the supporters on another amazing year and anyone else I may have forgotten. It's all of you wonderful people that make such a great "Club" and a pleasure to be involved with.

I would also like to thank the Sporties Club for its continued support and encourage all of our members to continue to support them also.

THIRD GRADE REPORT

From the start of the year, season 2012 was always destined to be a pretty successful year for third grade. We were defending premiers and had a line up that was looking stronger than the previous year, especially with the addition of two new pitchers, Alexander (AJ) and Lachy Wells who, although were only first year U16's, had shown they were ready for senior baseball.

Last year's grand final challengers, Phoenix, were not the force they had been in recent years but the Toronto Tigers filled the void to give us some tough games throughout the season.

After dominating the season with only the one loss to Toronto, we took out the Minor Premiership with a few games to spare and faced the Tigers in the Major Semi final at University Field. The game was close early but we went on to run away with the game in the end finishing up 9 -1 victors.

With the week off to prepare for the Grand Final, we received news that Toronto had won a close game against Phoenix to book a place in the season decider. We were keen for the challenge and play an in-form Tigers but perhaps the occasion got the better of us. We made some uncharacteristic errors and didn't play our best game against a team that probably played their best all year. The end of the first innings saw us at 1-1 but after a few errors in the second the Tigers stretched the lead out to 4-1. We scored another run in the 4th and with solid offence we shut the Toronto line up down until they scored two more in the 6th to put the game out of reach. The strong hitting that we had demonstrated all year was quiet on the day with Toronto out hitting us 10 - 3 and to finish up the game 6 runs to 2 winners.

Despite going down in the decider, it has to be said that the effort put in by the guys throughout the year was great to see and made the coaching job that much easier for myself and Hooky, in both putting the team together as well as winning games. The achievement of winning

the Minor Premiership is outstanding and proves that we were the team to beat all year. Well done boys.

Aside from being awarded the minor premiership, some other outstanding achievements for the year included Tim Graham winning the association Hitting Trophy with an average of .500%, with five other Belmont players also finishing in the top ten for batting average. AJ Wells showed he was certainly worthy of senior baseball when he was awarded the Association Most Valuable Player after performing consistently well all season both from the pitching mound and with the bat. His statistics show that at the end of the regular season, he had the lowest ERA of the competition at just 1.32%. It was a given that having received this award, he was also awarded the Belmont 3rd Grade MVP trophy and then went on to receive the prestigious Senior Rookie of the Year.

Lachlan Wells also had a fantastic year at club and representative level and his recent performances found him being selected as a member of the MLB Australian Baseball League Academy, which was an outstanding achievement. He finished the season for third grade as one of our best hitters with an average of .460 and an enviable ERA of 1.40%.

I would like to give special thanks to our Scorer extraordinaire Jenny Marjoribanks for once again helping out all season, to Hooky (of the lan variety) for assisting with the coaching and generally sharing your experience with both myself and the boys and also to all the players that graced the park in third grade, whether it was as a regular or just to fill in when we needed it. FOURTH GRADE REPORT

Fourth grade fell one game short of making the Grand Final this year, after coming second on the ladder during the regular season.

We couldn't manage a repeat of last year's success, and while we maintained our same team core as last year, we really missed some of the young talent that has since moved up to major league.

Fourth grade is always a tough competition and this year was no exception. We got a glimpse of what it is like to face major league pitching when we played Maitland, a team that contained a number of Newcastle representative players. We also came up against the perennially tough Nelson Bay Club, who never give up and play an intimidating style of the game.

Once again we had a solid team across the park, with a good mix of older experienced blokes, and some developing young talent that have bright futures in the game. We strung together some good wins throughout the season and were always near the top of the ladder.

We finished second on the ladder and came up against Maitland at Maitland in the major semi. Despite starting very strongly and holding our own for the first half of the game, we were always going to struggle against such talented opposition and we ultimately went down. The following week we came up against Nelson Bay in the final. We again played our best and were in it until the death, but went down by a couple to end our season.

Rowan Carpenter won the fourth grade MVP award this year. He played almost every position on the park and was always willing to fill-in wherever he was needed. Solid as a rock at centre field and dependable at third, second and short stop, Row once again also added some strength to our bullpen. A strong lead off batter and aggressive base runner, Row has been thereabouts for the MVP and batting awards for the past few years and this year is a well-deserving MVP.

Last year Sam Butler won the award for 'Punching above his Weight'. This year he earned the 4th grade 'Coach's Award'. Not sure whether that's a step up, or a step backwards (I know which one I'd prefer!). Anyway, Sam earned this award for his commitment to the team and willingness to fill in wherever he was needed. Sam made a come-back to the mound this year and showed he still has a lot of pitching talent. He fielded solidly in a number of different positions in the infield, and also put in some very good performances as a catcher. With the bat he racked up some decent numbers and hit some long balls. Sam announced his retirement from baseball this year for the 5th consecutive year, so we fully expect him to front up for fourth grade in 2013.

Greg (Beetle) Bayly was once again a standout at shortstop and always gives the team some strong defensive leadership. He is an extremely dependable batter and an aggressive base runner, despite his advancing age. Greg has declared that he is hanging up his 'short stop' boots and is looking to play a role that better suits his meagre throwing arm. DH or 'third-base-coach' are firming as options.

Chris Bruton found a home as a very capable first baseman this year due to an arm injury. He still hits the ball hard but probably didn't get the numbers we are used to from him this year.

Grant Harris came to us from u16s last year and acquitted himself very well in his first season in the senior grades. He was our main catcher and made a commendable effort to developing his talents throughout the season.

Nathan Connet is another young player who made his senior grade debut this year. Nathan was one of our main pitchers and put in some very impressive performances on the hill. When he wasn't pitching he played flawlessly in the outfield. He also batted some lead-off and his on-base percentage was excellent. Nathan can take a lot of the credit for the team finishing in second place on the ladder and is no doubt looking forward to cementing a position in major league next year.

After playing his first season in 5th grade last year, Derek Prentice was promoted to 4th grade this year. Derek can hold his own at this level, playing solidly in the outfield and making the most of some infield opportunities as well.
