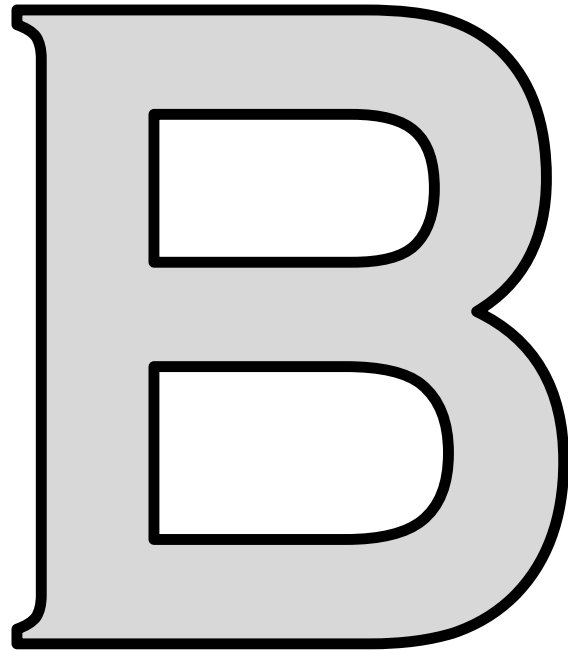

THIRD GRADE REPORT

The third grade team for 2013 was a fairly different outfit to the 2012 Minor Premiership team.

With only four players remaining from that side, we had a number of our young guys move in to fill the positions. We had three of our U16's in Jake Radford, Luke Bellamy & Zac Cootes, as well as two of our young minor leaguers, Nathan Connett & Zac Anthes, secure spots to make up the squad.

Once we settled into the season it was clear we had some strong competition with almost all teams capable of beating us on their day. With losses to Phoenix, Toronto and Whitesox in the regular season, we did enough to finish the season three games clear to secure the Minor Premiership and a place in the Major semi final.

Facing off against last year's Major premiers, Toronto, we knew it would be a tough game. We allowed them to get in the lead early scoring three runs in the first and what would be their only other run in the top of the third. That was almost enough for the Tigers when we came into the bottom of the 6th innings 2 runs down with little time remaining. With some great clutch hitting from the lower order in Scott Bubb and Zac Anthes, we managed to claw back two runs to tie the game, which was enough to secure our ticket to the 2013 Grand final. The following week, Toronto was upset by Boomerangs to give them their first Grand final berth in more than a decade.

Despite beating Boomers convincingly in each of the regular season games, we knew the grand final would be a much tougher prospect. After shutting Boomers down in the top of the first, we scored our opening run in the bottom to take an early lead. Boomers came out swinging in the second, scoring four runs to show us they were there to play ball. We hit straight back with another two runs but Boomers maintained their 4-3 lead until the fifth inning where we scored another two runs to take the lead. With Tim Graham on the mound keeping the Boomers bats quiet, they failed to score another run and with one more run from us, the Premiership was ours. Tim's performance on the mound was a

standout for us and earned him the NBA Player of the Grand Final award.

The third grade squad for 2013 is unlikely to go down as the strongest the club's ever had, but it was a squad that performed great as a team. It's worth mentioning a few players whose performances throughout the year made a significant contribution to the team and us taking out the premiership.

- Nathan Connett was our starting pitcher all year and did a fantastic job starting in his first senior grand final. He threw 54.4 innings for the season, conceding only 12 earned runs for an ERA of 1.99. This is an outstanding result at any level and after his first full season in the major league, I'm sure Nathan will be even more confident coming into season 2014.
- From rookie to senior staffer, Tim Graham proved once again that he is a force in third grade. He finished the season with an ERA of 0.00 after 19.4 innings and a batting average of 0.556 - second overall in the competition. For this effort, Tim earned himself the 3rd Grade MVP Award to go with his NBA Player of the Grand Final Award.
- Jake Radford played his first full season of seniors in the major league while still playing U16s. He was our catcher for the year doing a fantastic job for a young guy. On top of that, he was one of our better hitters finishing with an average of 0.375. For his outstanding performance, Jake was awarded the club's Senior Rookie of the Year Award.
- Zac Anthes was playing both fourth and third grades at the start of the season but soon became a permanent fixture in the third grade team. Although Zac looked very much at home in the outfield taking some great catches, it took a little while for him to display the same confidence in the batter's box. Early in the season he had an average of just 0.075 and led the competition in strikeouts, but with growing confidence and dedication to training, he turned that around to finish with an average of 0.306 and some crucial hits in the post season. Zac's enthusiasm, dedication and obvious improvement

throughout the season earned him the 3rd Grade Coaches Award.

- Dean Thompson was unfortunate to be shuffled out of 2nd grade after the numbers settled in the top grades. He quickly settled in to 3rds and was a very welcome addition to the team hitting 0.550 and becoming our permanent first baseman.

I would like to give special thanks to our Scorer Leeanne Connett for helping out all season as well as to Hooky (Ian) for assisting with the coaching. Finally, I would like to thank the 20 players that graced the park in third grade, in

particular, the core third grade team. It was one of my most enjoyable of many years largely due to you blokes.

FOURTH GRADE REPORT

The 2013 season for the Belmont 4th Grade team began immediately upon the close of the 2012 season.

Little did Sprucey and I know what "part time" really meant. Harris turned up for the 1st game, hit a home run and I'm not sure if we saw him again.

Finally in our recruitment drive, Jon MAGIN joined us from 3rd Grade. Jon was an unknown to me however I soon learnt that he liked to have a pitch and could throw a bit. I also learnt quickly never to ask him how he thought he was going, cause every time the reply was "yeah I'm good".

These four guys certainly bolstered the usual suspects in the club's 4th grade squad and at the start of the year the nickname "dream team" was bandied about by others within the club. The pressure to perform was on!

The season began with a loss, however, we quickly gained some consistency with the boys from major league again adjusting to using tin bats for the first time in many years. We finished the regular season in second place and played Nelson Bay in the Major Semi Final, winning 12-1. We again faced off against The Bay in the Grand Final and won 12-5.
