General Business:

Matt Ireland asked for an email written by John Lambkin to be read out by Stephen in his absence and be discussed. Would Belmont club like to submit 2 first grade teams into the 2014 season ? This is mainly to eliminate the bye in first grade. Would it help retain Juniors?

Discussion:

Andrew Poole – fears of a division within the club. It has been done previously many years ago. One team was constantly playing away. It is a noble idea. However, history is a good indicator of the future.

Paul Ireland – he canvassed this issue with NBA. Most clubs were happy with the 5 clubs being in the grade. He believes a 2nd 1st grade team will not be of benefit. Eliminating the bye does not benefit baseball. It is not up to our club to rectify this issue. It would prove to be detrimental to the harmony of the club.

Duane Harrison – he didn't like the idea of a 2nd 1st grade team. He felt like the team was not a part of the club and it wouldn't be a good outcome for Belmont. But from an NBA point, it may not be the answer for the problem. It's the first he has heard of it. It was not through any endorsement from the NBA board. We need to concentrate on our Juniors. It will not be a short term fix. After talking to Central Coast recently, they have no plans to end their winter comp.

Cameron Davis – we should not be penalised for the hard work that we have done for juniors. Other clubs should stand up and do more. It should not be our responsibility.

Matthew Hawke – only strategic plan is to increase Juniors.
