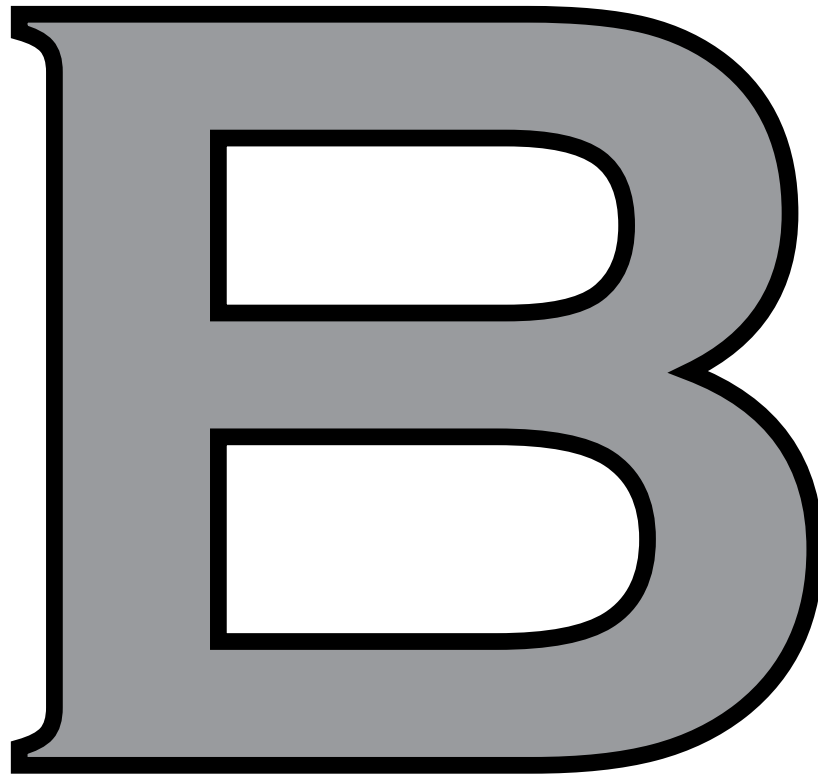

Special thanks to my senior playing group in Adam Herrera, Stephen Hook, Matthew Ireland and

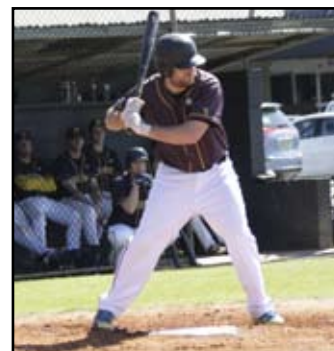
