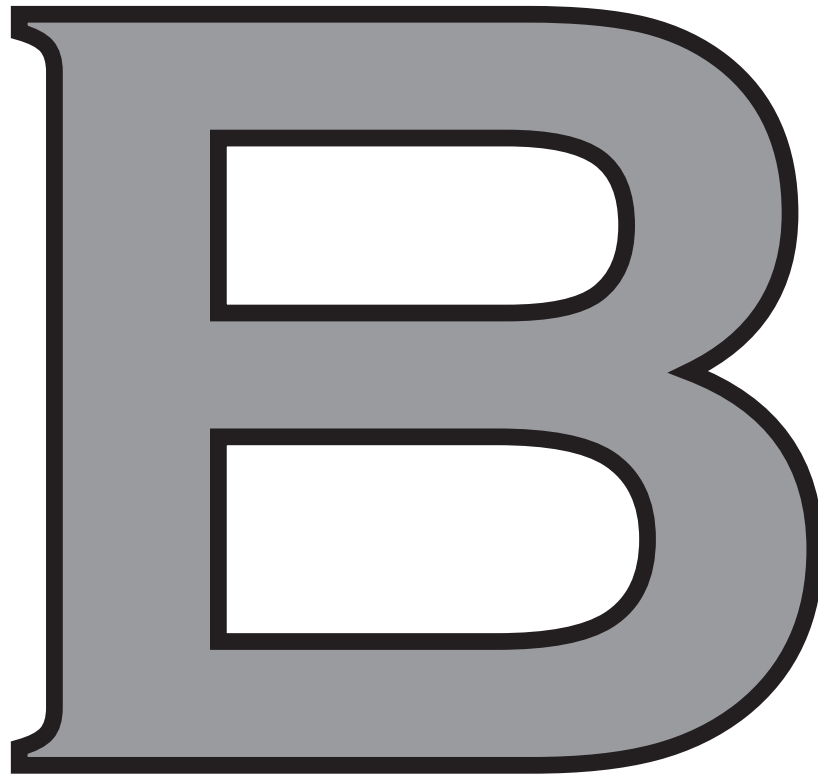

President's Report

Another year and another very successful season for the Belmont Baseball Club. I'd firstly like to congratulate everyone involved for a great year.

2016 started with some much needed ground works on Lumsdon Oval in preparation for the Combined High Schools State Tournament. The tournament consisted of 7 teams from around the state compete for the NSW CHS Title. Despite some torrential rain just before the tournament started we managed to get all games on over the 4 day carnival. The mid-week carnival was a great success and a great promotion for baseball and our club in the community. A big thank you to everyone who gave up there time to assist throughout the week.

This year we fielded 2 teams in every junior age division and it was great to see the kids enjoy themselves and learn and develop new skills throughout the year. Our teams were fairly even and the results achieved were terrific. We were junior club champions for the second year in a row and it is great to see the hard work paying off that our coaches put in to train the kids. As always the juniors are our lifeblood and it is imperative that we continue to grow our junior base and ensure we have a high standard of baseball throughout our club and the Newcastle competition. I would also like to thank Kim Hook for the work she has done this year off the field to ensure the juniors ran smoothly.

A change in the format of the competition was going to be a big challenge for our club this year, as the change affected both juniors and seniors and was not suited to the bigger clubs in the area. We did a great job dealing with this change and it was extremely pleasing to see the results our club managed to achieve. Once again we were one of the few clubs that fielded teams in every grade as well as multiple teams in 3rd and 4th grades and all 4 teams made the semis. 3rd grade Sporties were minor and major premiers and 4th grade saw the Sporties v Seagulls grand final and was a great game of baseball played in the right spirit with the Seagulls eventual winner. Whilst we will need to look at the playing numbers next season to see if we can sustain 4 teams across the 2 grades, I would like to thank everyone involved in the 4 teams (2 squads) for making it work this year, especially the 2 coaches Hooky and Packy.

1st and 2nd grades were there usual competitive selves with the 2 sides both making the grand final. Whilst it wasn't 2nd grades year 1st grade were by far the best team in the competition. They took out the minor premiership with about 4 or 5 games remaining in the regular competition, they were narrowly defeated in the major semi-final by Toronto, cruised to victory in the final against White Sox 10-0 and then put on a hitting display in the grand final. In a very unique game that saw Belmont and Toronto

combine to have 40 hits with Belmont in the end winning comfortably 18-12. This win capped off a great year for this team by seeing them become the most successful team in our clubs history by winning 9 consecutive grand finals and breaking a record 8 straight grand final wins set back in 1978 through to 1985. Obviously the goal now is for the 10th win and a decade of 1st grade premierships.

Having 8 senior teams and 7 junior teams this year and being the only club with 2 full size playing fields meant that we had a home game of some sort every weekend. This meant our hard working volunteers never got a rest and it also meant finding other volunteers from time to time was hard to achieve. I would like to thank everyone who volunteered their time week in week out to help run the club and I challenge all of you to put your hand up from time to time to assist. If only for a couple of hours, we are always looking for umpires, grounds people, canteen and bbq staff.

It was also great to regain the senior Club Championship, after Toronto claimed it in 2015 it gave us something to work harder for and was pleasing to see our hard work on and off the field pay off. I am already looking forward to next season as we have some bright young stars coming through and our club looks to be in great shape for many years to come.

I'd like to thank all of the coaches, scorers, bbq and canteen staff, grounds crew, umpires and of course the committee for all of your hard work throughout the year, it really is a thankless job you all do and you continue to do so week in and week out and I really can't thank you all enough.

LMCC has a sports master plan to develop the Belmont sports grounds to provide modern sporting facilities that support our growing community. This master plan is available for public comment on the councils website and I encourage everyone to have a look.

Lastly I'd like to thank the Sporties club for its ongoing commitment especially through tough times, unfortunately the Wests amalgamation did not go through but the club has a new owner and I encourage everyone to support the club and ensure its longevity.
