

## **Batting Facility Authorised Member Agreement**

**This Authorised Member Agreement has been established by the Concord Baseball Club (the Club) and applies to any individual appointed by the Club as an Authorised member to operate the Batting Facility on behalf of the Club.**

**The purpose of the Authorised Member Agreement is to ensure the safe and efficient usage of the batting cage and to meet our legal and operational requirements.**

**This user agreement must be read in conjunction with the batting cage rules which must be observed by everyone using the facility including individual players, Club members, casual visitors, coaches and Club officials.**

**Individuals and/or teams observed to be in violation of the batting cage rules, violation of this agreement and / or abusive use and/or damaging the batting cages will be ejected from the facility and subject to loss of privilege as deemed appropriate by the Club executive committee.**

### **1. Keys and Access**

**1.1 Keys to the Batting facility are “Restricted Keys” and will only be issued to:**

- Committee members who have agreed to be available to open, close and supervise the use of the facility; and**
- The coach or manager of live ball teams.**

**Only one key per team will be issued.**

- 1.2 Keys to Batting Facility issued to an Authorised Member remain the responsibility of the Authorised Member and must be returned to the Club at the conclusion of the season or as otherwise directed by the Club executive committee. A security bond of \$100 (refundable on return of the key) will apply.**
- 1.3 Keys must not be lent to any individual or third party (other than to another Authorised Member) without the permission of a member of the Club executive committee.**
- 1.4 When providing access to individuals or teams for the use of the facility, there must be an Authorised Member present at all times while facility is in use.**

## **2. Bookings**

- 2.1 Regular and casual bookings to use the facility should be made via the online booking system on the Concord Comets Website and will generally take priority except for game days where the Concord home team will take priority to use the facility for up to one hour before their game (Note: the Concord home team includes teams from Rosebank and St Patrick's Colleges);**
- 2.2 Regular bookings will generally be limited to Concord teams (including teams from Rosebank and St Patrick's Colleges) however the use of the batting facility by Concord teams and players outside of team bookings on a casual basis is encouraged and subject to availability on a "first come first in" basis. Casual bookings must be made through the booking system and in periods of high demand users need to be mindful of other users and limit the time and lanes being used. The executive committee reserves the right to cancel bookings at any time.**

**2.3 The batting facility is generally not available for use by third parties Any requests by third parties wishing to use the batting facility are to be directed to the President, Concord Baseball Club.**

### **3. Authorised Members**

**3.1 A list of current Authorised members is available on the Concord Baseball Club website (under the Batting Facility Booking System). Unless otherwise approved by a member of the Concord Club executive committee, Authorised members are limited to the Club's executive committee and live ball coaches (LL Major and above) and must have attended a briefing on the operation and use of the Batting Facility.**

**3.2 All Authorised members are deemed to have agreed to, and abide by this Authorised Member Agreement, the Batting Facility Rules of Use, the Concord Baseball Club's Code of Conduct and the Baseball NSW Member Protection Policy.**
