

Accreditation Levels – what it qualifies you for

Level	Qualification For
Level 0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o N/A – Introductory only. o Recognition of awareness of how to score using correct symbols and introduction to colours
Level S	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Score school / Club junior grade
Level 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Score Club / school level up to but not including State / Territory's highest level
Level 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Score Club level at State / Territory's highest level of competition up to, but not including National Tournaments o Score intra-state school / university competition
Level IT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Appointed IT Scorer at official ABF tournament o Act as a computer IT Scorer recording live game and / or “play by play” utilising ABF computer program at ABF, State and Club levels.
Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Team appointed scorer at official ABF tournament o Tournament Scorers Coordinator (TSC) for an intra-state tournament including schoolboys, university and visiting youth / friendship tournaments o To facilitate Level O and Level 1 Accreditations <p>++ Game Scorer at National Tournaments ++ Upon application to CABS, more experienced Level 3 Scorers may be identified and subsequently qualify for further training with a view to participating as a Chief Scorer - manual / hard copy system only - at National Tournaments.</p>
Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Planning and conducting scoring Clinic(s). o Teaching / instructing at any level. o Tournament Scorers Coordinator at any tournament under the auspices of the ABF. o Provide calls of game plays to a Level 4IT using the ABF official computer statistical package (currently Automated Scorebook). o Instruction on the IBAF scoring methodology. o International competition scoring assignment.
Level 4 IT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Planning and conducting scoring Clinic(s). o Teaching / instructor at any level o Tournament Scorers Coordinator at any tournament under the auspices of the ABF o Providing assistance on the use of ABF official computer statistical package (currently Automated Scorebook) for Level 4IT only. o Instruction on the IBAF scoring methodology o International competition scoring assignments
