Applicants are required to agree to and sign the Code of Conduct below

As a Scorer I will:

- *Sit with the opposition scorer in a neutral scoring location;
- *Remain in the designated scoring location until all post game duties have been completed;
- *Encourage sportsmanlike behaviour amongst scorers, recognise that swearing or verbal abuse of players, officials or umpires will not be tolerated;
- *Not consume/use unapproved substances on or adjacent to the diamond. This includes, not smoking at any time while scoring;
- *Set a good example in my appearance and behaviour;
- * Never be guilty of barracking or coaching whilst scoring;
- *Never be guilty of making criticism of other scorers, umpires, coaches or team members by word or gesture;
- *Never draw players or coaches attention to rule infringements, such as 'batting out of Order', a runner missing home plate or any base, or any other call along similar lines;
- * Never bring an Umpire's attention to an incorrect count unless he/she asks for confirmation of the count;
- * Will always fill out my Scoresheet and any Result Sheet correctly at all times and never change scores, pitch counts, defensive outs, etc. to something that I know is not correct;
- *Always provide help to other scorers at all times.
