**D5: BASEBALL ADMINISTRATORS' CODE OF BEHAVIOUR**

In addition to Baseball's General Code of Behaviour ([Part D1](#)), administrators must meet the following requirements in regard to conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of the ABF, a member association, or an affiliated club.

- (1) Resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures.
- (2) Maintain strict impartiality.
- (3) Be aware of your legal responsibilities.
