

BBA Award Qualifications

A, B & C Grade Batting Awards:

Awarded to the Player with the highest Batting Average in their division in the Association but Awarded to the Player with the highest number of plate appearances for that division.

B & C Grade Fielding Awards:

Awarded to the Player with the highest Fielding Average in the Association, but must also have played in at least 2/3 of the highest number of games for that division.

Umpires Award:

Selected by the Umpires of the BBA. The winners may have been a valuable contributor to the team, but no necessarily quality for an award in their division.

Coaches Award:

Selected by the opposing coaches in the division, a 3-2-1 vote is submitted by all senior coaches. It is for who they believe has played well throughout the session, or contributed most to their team.

A Grade Golden Gloves:

Awarded to the Player with the highest Fielding Average in a position on the diamond where they have played at least 30 innings. The Golden Gloves are awarded for the positions of Catcher, 1st Base, 2nd Base, 3rd Base, Short Stop, Left Field, Centre Field, Right Field.

Leigh Tuckerman Rookie of the Year:

Awarded to a Player who is Under 18 years of age but no longer eligible to play with the junior competition of the Association, and who has played at least 5 A Grade games throughout the season in their Club. The winner is chosen by a 3-2-1 vote from opposing A Grade Coaches.

Peter Murphy Memorial Perpetual Trophy:

Awarded to the best player of the Senior State Winter Championships, as selected by the Coach. Donated and presented by the Murphy Family.

John Newman Pitching Award:

Awarded to A Grade Player with the lowest Earned Run Average. Must have pitched a minimum of 20 innings.

Champion Club Trophy:

Awarded to the Club via a point system, based on the number of wins that Club has had in the following divisions:-

A Grade, B Grade, C Grade, Under 16, and Under 13/12. 10 points are awarded per A Grade win, 6 points awarded per B Grade win, 4 points awarded per C Grade win, 2 points are awarded for each U16 and U13/12 win. If a club has more than one team in the division, only one team will have the points calculated for their wins. In the event of a draw, the point for a win are halved and given to each team.
