Mt Victoria Lookout (left)

The Lookout is easily accessible from Wellington's city centre and offers 360 degree scenic views. There are several routes you can take walking up Mount Victoria. Most of them will lead you through bush or a pine forest before reaching the peak.

Museum of NZ Te Papa Tongarewa (right)

Te Papa is New Zealand's bold and innovative national museum and a recognised world leader in interactive and visitor-focused museum experiences.



Wellington's Cable Car (left)

The Wellington Cable Car is a funicular railway in Wellington, between Lambton Quay, the main shopping street, and Kelburn, a suburb in the hills overlooking the central city, rising 120m over a length of 612m.

The Winding House (right)

Which has been given Category 2 Heritage Status by the NZ Historic Places Trust houses the winding gear which pulled Wellington's first cable cars. Now is the home to two of the original grip cars, restored to their former glory as well as the historic winding machinery.



Weta Studio (right)

Weta Studio Tours is your gateway to immersive film-making experiences—situated in Miramar, Wellington.



Wainui Lookout (left)

An amazing view of the Hutt Valley, river and Wellington Harbour. Free but you have to drive over the hill to Wainouiomata and back again to be able to park in the viewing area. Well worth it though.

Katherine Mansfield House & Garden (left)

This was the home of Katherine Mansfield, New Zealand's most famous author. The building is located at 25 Tinakori Rd, Thorndon, Wellington and is classified as a Category 1 historic place by Heritage New Zealand.



Korokoro Dam (right)

Great walking track. Following the Korokoro Stream to the dam is a great way to relax and enjoy nature. The track is comfortable for all to walk and has many bridges crossing the stream.



Wellington Botanic Gardens (left)

The gardens cover 25 hectares of land on the side of the hill between Thorndon and Kelburn, near central Wellington. It also features the stunning Begonia House.



The Old Bank Arcade (right)

Occupies a heritage site that formerly housed the BNZ and is located on the cnr of Lambton Quay & Hunter Streets.
