NBTA offers the following options for Interclub competition for the 2018/19 season.

Definitions:

- Long deuce – normal full tennis deuce and advantage
- Short deuce – 1 normal deuce and advantage then sudden death
- Sudden death – one point decider receiver chooses side
- Conventional tie break - played first to 7 with a margin of 2.
- Match tie break – (super tie break) first to 10 with a margin of 2.

Monday morning Women - 9am warmup prompt 9.30am start. 4 person team. All matches up to 9. Conventional tie break at 8 all. Each player partners each of the other players on the team. Short deuce to be played to player of corresponding merit. i.e. Player 3 serves to player 3

Monday B Grade Women, Pool A – 5.45pm. Teams to be entered by club convenor on their merit as the club convenor sees fit. 2 person team. Each player will play one doubles and one singles. Long deuce. *3 courts used (maximum)*. Team numbers dependant, this league will play 2 rounds leading up to Christmas to be followed by Cameron Cup semis and finals between top 4 teams. Wednesday Social Womens Dbls – 5.45pm. 4 person team. Three matches to 6, with a conventional tie break at 6 all, thus playing with each person on the team. Short deuce to be played to player of corresponding merit. i.e. Player 3 serves to player 3.

Wednesday Intermediate Grade Womens Dbls 5-45pm 2 person team. This is a **women's** only league. 3 full sets played, conventional tie break at 6 all, long deuce. Bonus point to winner of the 3rd set. If possible, this grade will be played at the same venue.

Wednesday Competitive Womens Dbls 5-45pm 2 person team. This is a **women's** only league. 3 full sets played, conventional tie break at 6 all, long deuce. Bonus point to winner of the 3rd set.

Thursday A Mixed Doubles. – 5.45pm. 4 person team, 2 ladies and 2 men. 1 doubles and 1 mixed doubles best of 3 sets, conventional tie break at 6 all, match tie break 3rd set. Short deuce.

Thursday B mixed Doubles – 5-45pm. 4 person team, 2 ladies and 2 men. 1 doubles and 1 mixed doubles, best of 3 sets, conventional tie break at 6 all, match tie break 3rd set. Short deuce.

Thursday C Mixed Doubles – 5.45pm. 4 person team, combination of ladies and men. Three matches to 6, with a conventional tie break at 6 all, thus playing with each person on the team. Short deuce.

Saturday Afternoon Mixed Doubles. – 1.45pm. 4 person team, 2 ladies and 2 men. 1 doubles and 1 mixed doubles best of 3 sets, conventional tie break at 6 all, match tie break 3rd set. Short deuce

Team entries: All team entries are to go through the club captain only. Captains - enter teams directly on line via Configure Ranking. Results - entered directly on line by the winning team via Configure Ranking as per last year. Ali will be in contact with each club captain with their entry instructions. Entries close on 1st October 2017.
